

Make Your Own Sloth

Material:

- Paper Plate
- Recycled Paper Towel Roll
- Construction Paper
- Paint
- Paint Brushes
- Googly Eyes
- Dead Leaves From Outside (With Parent Supervision)

Objective: Explorers will get to use their creativity skills and make their own sloth!

Lesson:

- Begin by painting your paper towel roll a dark brown and your paper plate a grey/light brown color
- Once dry, glue your paper towel roll toward the top of a piece of construction paper.
- Cut your plate in half and glue one of the halves with the circle part on the bottom of the piece of construction paper.
- With the other half cut out a circle (head of sloth) and four limbs (arms and legs)
- Glue these to the appropriate areas to complete the body of you sloth
- Next, with parent supervision, go outside and collect several dead leaves
- Bring these back inside and glue them to and around your paper towel roll (this will be the tree limb your sloth hangs from)
- Add googly eyes to your sloth and any other items you would like to add to your artwork.
- Let dry and you have completed your sloth!
