 - Only use items we have a surplus of

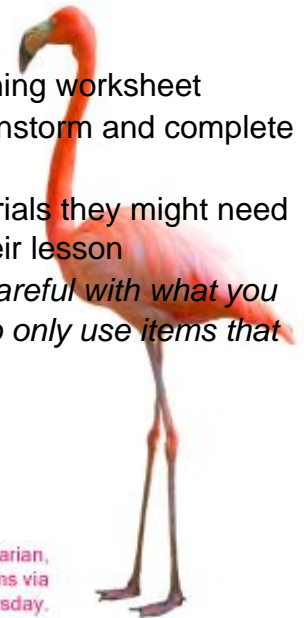
Objective: Explorers will learn how to create their own lesson, how to explain instructions to others, and how to present in front of a group of people



Lesson:

- Give explorers one lesson planning worksheet
- Take roughly 15 minutes to brainstorm and complete sheet
- Once done, ask kids what materials they might need to help create an example of their lesson
- *Grab items for kids to use. Be careful with what you give them and how much. Try to only use items that we have a surplus of*
